

SANTA FE ARTISTS MARKET, INC
Jury Criteria & Media Categories 2017

The Santa Fe Artists Market will base their selection of artists on the overall impact, creativity, originality, design and quality of craftsmanship of artwork as well as the quality of materials. Presentation of artwork and booth photo will be equally important.

Categories

Ceramics: All original clay and porcelain work other than jewelry is accepted in this category. No machine-made or mass produced work is permitted. Each piece must be signed.

Drawing: Works created using dry media including chalk, charcoal, pastels, pencil, wax crayon, etc. or from the fluid medium of inks and washes applied by pen or brush are to be entered in this category. All work must be signed or marked by the artist.

Fiber: All work crafted from fibers including basketry, embroidery, weaving, leatherwork, tapestry, wearable art, and papermaking. No machine tooling, machine-screened patterns or other forms of mass production are permitted. No factory produced wearable items, regardless of additional modification or enhancement by the artist, may be exhibited. All items must be labeled with artist's name.

Glass: Fused, blown and lampwork glass are included in this category.

Jewelry: All jewelry, whether the work is produced from metal, glass, clay, fiber, paper, plastic or other materials must be entered in this category. All entries to the jewelry category, whether fine or ornamental, must be of original design and handmade by the artist. No commercial casts, molds or assembled work is allowed. Only those artists accepted into the jewelry category may display or sell jewelry. No strung beadwork is being accepted at this time.

Metal: Includes all non-sculptural, non-jewelry works crafted from metals.

Mixed Media: This category includes works, both 2 and 3-dimensional, that incorporate more than one type of physical material to produce. Includes non-sculptural work as determined by the artist. All works must be signed or marked by the artist.

Painting: Works created in oils, acrylics, watercolor, etc. are in this category. All work must be signed or marked by the artist.

Photography: Photographic prints, signed and numbered, made from the artist's original image, which have been processed by that artist, or under his or her direct supervision, are included in this category. Photographers are required to disclose both their creative and printing processes.

Sculpture: Three-dimensional original work done in any medium. All work must be signed or marked by the artist.

Wood: Original works in wood that are hand-tooled, machine-worked, turned or carved are accepted in this category.

Other: Any work that does fall into the stated categories.

Note: Any Jewelry displayed in booth must be juried in the "Jewelry" category.
